During inspections of the depots, It is observed operational planner is not planned properly due to manual preparation and review of actual operated kms vis-a-vis planned kms is not being done.

In order to overcome above problem, IT Department has developed web based software for data entry of operational planner by Regional Office. The following is the procedure to implement the above software.

PROCEDURE:

1. Login www.apsrtcinfo.com select "DCP" tab and select "Operational planner" tab and the following menu will appear.

2. OPERATIONAL PLANNER DATA ENTRY - Operational planner details to be entered in the RM's Office computer system.

- 3. OPERATIONAL PLANNER MODIFICATION Operational planner details may be modified with EDIT option only from 25th to 5th of every
- 4. OPERATIONAL PLANNER REPORT Operational planner report may be generated as and when required.
- 5. PASSWORD CHANGE Password change facility is provided to the RM's Office for security & correct Operational planner.

By entering the depot-wise Operational planner details at RM's Office it is easy to generate web based operational report showing actual operated kms against planned kms so as to improve operational performance.

Hence, it is requested to instruct the Dy.CTMs/Depot Managers to utilize the web based software at all the depots for feeding the Operational planner details at RM's Office before 1st of every month and utilize web based daily Operational report for improving performance.
