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It has been represented by the Computers Departments that several Core Group Supervisors in the category of Conductors, who are trained on various DCP Projects, have been selected to the post of Junior Assistants (Personnel/Finance) in the recent selections conducted and several others are also likely to get selected on going selections. Such of those conductors working in Regional Core Group and who are trained in various modules of DCP at a lot of effort and time, if shifted from the Regions where they are working without providing suitable trained substitute adversely affects the DCP Projects and the Computers Department has requested for continuing them in the selected post of Junior Assistant (Personnel/Finance) at the respective places of work.

The matter has been examined by VC&MD based on the recommendations of Computers Department and it is decided to post the candidates belonging to Regional Core Group and selected as Junior Assistant (Personnel/Finance) at the same Region for a period of one year. The Computers Department is advised to train substitute candidates in those places within the period of one year.



Vide letter cited above it was informed that misappropriation in Sale of Bus Passes by the depot system incharge has occurred at Chittor -1 depot. To avoid such incidents, guidelines were given to rotate the system incharges once in 3 years to other depots within the Region.

In view of strengthening the OLTAS bus pass module and introduction of TIMS for all Pallevelugu services at all the Depots, such incidents have not surfaced during the last 4 years.

Centralised Integrated System (CIS) Project is now being implemented in APSRTC. For successful implementation of the CIS Project, the depot system incharges have to play a key role in Data Migration, testing of the software, training to all ADCs and others and ensuring proper functioning of Network in addition to their regular duties. In view of the complexity of the CIS Project the depot system incharge should be an experienced one to overcome all the problems that could occur at the time of implementation.

It is hereby advised not to transfer the existing depot system incharges till implementation and stabilization of the CIS Project. In case of any administrative reasons like promotion and misconduct etc., such cases may be referred to the undersigned and obtain permission for transfer of such employees.
