**SUB: HEAD LIGHT BULBS - Stopping usage of Halogen Head light Bulbs on our Vehicles - Certain instructions issued - Reg.**

**In the year 1995 a decision was taken to use Halogen Head Light Bulbs on all long distance night service Buses for better vision to the Drivers. Further it was decided to use the Halogen Bulbs to all Vehicles except City in the year 1997 basing on the satisfactory performance of Halogen Bulbs.**

**Now the draft CMVR - 1997 has banned the use of Halogen Bulbs with P 45t cap for the passenger Vehicles. However they have recommended the use of Halogen Bulbs of P 43t cap type which is not suitable to our Vehicles.**

**After detailed discussions with the Vehicle manufacturers and Bulb manufacturers the Sub Committee (T&S) of ASRTU has strongly recommended that a provision should be made in the CMVR to ban the production of Halogen Bulbs other than those covered by IS : 1606.**

**In view of the above it is decided not to use Halogen Head Light Bulbs to our Vehicles and use only ordinary Bulbs with immediate effect.**
