Pallevelugu and City Buses - Instructions issued - Reg.

Display of proper destination board which provides information to the passengers is one of the pre-requisite for providing passenger friendly transport services. Instructions were issued vide circular cited at reference1 on the display of destination boards in buses way back in 2001. Later on display of destination boards was standardized vide circular at reference 2 in all special type vehicles viz., Garuda, Meghdoot, Super Luxury, Deluxe and Express buses with service nos., its lettering and color code. The above circular did not cover City Ordinary, Metro Express and Pallevelugu buses. During the recent inspections of buses at bus stations and depots, it is noticed that display of destination boards in buses is not uniform and not informative to the passengers. It was also observed that the destination boards are not visible properly from outside as they are not close to the destination glass as possible. This was also emphasized by the VC&MD in a meeting held with Dy.CMEs/WMs on 04-05-2010. In view of the above the circular instructions are once again reiterated here under on display of proper destination boards in all buses.

- Garuda, Super Luxury buses: The circular instructions issued vide reference-2 shall be followed scrupulously. Further display of via places shall be incorporated in the destination display boards which were not mentioned in the earlier circular and Telugu font style may be changed to 'Kranti' as the earlier font is not available now.
- 2. <u>Deluxe and Express buses:</u> The circular instructions issued vide reference-2 shall be followed scrupulously. The location of destination boards in the box shall be as nearer to glass as possible leaving space for fluorescent tube light so that visibility of board can be enhanced. Telugu font style may be changed to 'Kranti' as the earlier font is not available now.

- 3. Pallevelugu, Metro Express and City Ord buses: Front and Rear destination boards in Ashok Leyland and Eicher buses, rear destination boards in TATA buses shall be exhibited in the destination boxes provided in roof. Front destination board for TATA buses shall be displayed in the destination box provided at cant level on left side. Side destination board shall be displayed in the destination box provided at top fixed glass area of 1<sup>st</sup> window on LH side. The size of boards shall be 910mmx 210 mm and shall be located as nearer to glass as possible leaving space for fluorescent tube light so that that visibility of board can be enhanced.
  - i. The front and rear destination boxes shall be illuminated with 2' length fluorescent tube light assembly with acrylic cover and the side destination box shall be illuminated with 6W bulbs provided in brass pendent holders.
  - ii. The destination boards shall be made to the size in 1.22 mm thick G.I. sheet and pasted with good quality pressure sensitive adhesive back vinyl sticker sheet having printed the details of route, route no., via places on it.
  - iii. The details of size, colour, type of font and font sizes shall be as per the details at Annexure-I.
  - iv. The display of destination boards shall be as per the lay-outs mentioned at Annexure-II

The vinyl sticker shall be replaced as and when the color fades away due to UV light effect.

All the Depot Managers are here by instructed to implement the above instructions with immediate effect and submit a compliance report to the respective Regional Managers.

All Regional Managers and Dy.CMEs are advised to closely monitor the implementation of above circular instructions and report compliance so as to appraise the same to VC & MD.
