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Strategic steps have already been taken to revert the negative trends in Tyre performance. The field units have been equipped with redefined guidelines / strategies for both the adhoc and long term basis Tyre management touching all aspects of Tyre maintenance / management.

In this connection, the role of tyre section supervisor is once again emphasised in **proper accountal of tyre mileages and tyre management aspects of utilisation of first come first basis, avoiding idling of tyres, rotation of tyres etc.** The subject was discussed in detail in the recently concluded WMs, Dy.CMEs and AMEs(T) meeting held at H.O.

It is noticed that frequent change of tyre section supervisor is resulting in improper tyre management in the Tyre section in addition to wrong posting of mileages due to lack of awareness and acquaintance with the computerized Data Bank.

Hence the selection of proper supervisor and retention of the same supervisor in Tyres section for a considerable period shall be thought of as a part of Tyre management. Computerisation of the section also warrants such action to sustain the systems' effective implementation. This will go in a long way in sustaining the Tyre management systems at Depot level. All the Regional Managers are therefore requested to see that **suitable supervisor is available in Tyre section and subsequently retained for a period of at least three years in the section for streamlining the tyre management practices at the Depots.** If needed, required training shall be imparted to such supervisors.
