The instructions issued on the subject of overtime have been reviewed in the light of discussions held on 10.01.2000 as quoted at reference 2 above.

In view of the commencement of peak season it becomes necessary at times to book crew on double duty to ensure that services are not cancelled causing inconvenience to the commuters.

As already discussed in the meeting, no uniform instructions can be issued from Corporate Office with regard to quantum of payment of advance amount to perform double duty. Depending upon the local situation and the operational needs of the Organisation, the Regional Managers have to take action in this regard.

As far as payment of overtime is concerned, the employees have to submit the claim form for OT within three months. The Depot Manager concerned shall satisfy himself about the correctness of the claim and make arrangements for payment of the same duly taking sanction of the competent authority. If any employee fails to submit the claim form for OT within three months, he will not be eligible for the OT wages.

The instructions issued in the circular 1st cited are modified to the extent indicated above. The other conditions stipulated in the circular cited stand good.
