Sub: **NGO'S BUS PASSES** - Issue of Monthly General Bus Tickets to NGOs of A.P. State Govt. working in twin cities, Vijayawada, Visakhapatnam and Warangal - Extending the facility to travel by Metro Express services in twin cities on payment of difference of fare - Permission accorded by the Govt. of A.P. - Instructions issued - Reg.

Corporation is presently issuing two types of Monthly General Bus Tickets i.e., G B T (City Ord.) and G B T (Sub-urban Ord.) to the NGOs of A.P. State Govt. working in twin cities, Vijayawada, Visakhapatnam and Warangal. The cost of the pass is shared in the ratio of 1:2 between the NGO and the A.P. State Govt. as detailed below.

Based on the representation made by the Members of A.P. Civil Services Joint Staff Council (State level), the Government of A.P. have accorded approval to permit all the Govt. employees holding concessional bus passes to travel by Metro Express services subject to the condition that the differential amount between the Metro Express Bus Pass rate and the prevailing rates of NGOs bus passes would be borne by the employees who are willing to take the Metro Express bus pass.

The Government have also directed the Corporation in the G.O. cited to implement the said facility and to take action in the matter accordingly.

After examining the issue in detail, the following instructions are therefore issued to the Regional Manager, HCR for compliance.

- 1) As the Corporation is issuing only one type of Metro Express general bus ticket (Monthly) to the general public priced at Rs.440/-, which is valid both on City as well as Sub-urban routes, the same type of pass is to be issued to the NGOs willing to avail Metro Express Monthly general bus ticket, in twin cities of Hyderabad & Secunderabad.
- 2) As there is no change in the amount of share of the Government in respect of NGOs availing NGOs bus pass, both within City limits and upto Sub-urban limits i.e., Rs.207.00 and Rs.247.00 respectively, the differential amount between the Metro Express bus pass rate and the prevailing rates of NGOs bus passes payable by the NGOs will be as detailed below, as clarified by the Govt. vide letter 2nd cited.
 - a) The NGO who is hitherto utilising GBT (City services), if willing to avail Metro Express bus pass has to bear the differential amount between the Metro Express bus pass rate and City bus pass rate i.e., Rs.130/- extra per month (Rs.440 - 310 = 130) in addition to the amount he / she is already paying Rs.103/- for City pass. Thus, the total amount payable by the employee comes to Rs.233/- (Rs.103 + Rs.130) and the Government will reimburse its existing share of Rs.207/- only.
 - b) In case of NGO who is hitherto utilising GBT (Sub-urban), if willing to avail Metro Express bus pass, has to bear the differential amount between the Metro Express bus pass rate and Sub-urban bus pass rate i.e., Rs.70/- extra per month (Rs.440 - 370 = 70), in addition to the amount the employee is already paying for taking NGOs Sub-urban bus pass i.e., Rs.123/-. Thus, the total amount payable by the employee holding NGOs bus pass for Sub-urban service comes to Rs.193/- (Rs.123 + 70) and the Government will reimburse its existing share of Rs.247/- only.
- 3) The Works Manager (P&S), BBW, Miyapur shall take action for printing two types of Metro Express NGOs General bus tickets with pre-printed value of Rs.233.00 and Rs.193.00 for utilization by NGOs. (City) and NGOs. (Sub-urban) respectively.
- 4) Holders of these Metro Express Monthly GBTs are allowed to perform un-restricted travel by City ordinary as well as Metro Express services under operation upto Sub-urban limits.
- 5) The Dy.CAO of the Region concerned shall arrange to prefer claim on the Government for payment of its share @ Rs.207.00 per pass in case of NGOs. utilising Rs.233.00 Metro Express GBTs, and at Rs.247.00 per pass in case of NGOs. utilising Rs.193.00 Metro GBT. based on the number of Metro Express GBTs issued during the month, along with regular NGOs bills, as is being done now.

- 6) As and when the tariff of GBTs whether City Ordinary or Metro Express is hiked, the Government of A.P. will continue to pay its share in the ratio of 1:2 (between the NGO and the Government) applicable for City Ordinary monthly general bus ticket only, while the difference cost applicable for Metro Express is to be borne by the NGO only, who are willing to avail Metro Express bus passes.
- 7) The NGOs Associations may be informed that they shall not insist for operation of Office Specials of "Metro" type as they are very limited in number and their existing scheduled operations can not be disturbed.
- 8) All other existing terms and conditions applicable to issue of NGOs bus passes, shall continue to apply to the NGOs willing to avail Metro Express Monthly General bus tickets.
- 9) This facility shall come into force w.e.f. 01.04.2005.
