Sub:--LICENCES - Sale of Mineral Water in Bus Stations - Giving permission to licensees of Canteens/Stalls to sell Mineral Water at an extra licence fee - Regarding.

Of late, the consumption of Mineral water by the travelling public has been increasing. Taking advantage of this situation, the licensees of various Stalls/Canteens are selling Mineral water, even though they are not permitted to sell Mineral water. Clarifications are being sought by some Unit Officers on sale of Mineral Water by the licensees of Stalls/Canteens.

The issue of sale of Mineral Water by the licensees of Stalls/Canteens was also discussed during the Meeting of Executive Directors/Regional Managers/Heads of the Departments held on 29.3.2001. To avoid litigation and complaints, a decision was taken that the licensees of various Stalls/Canteens should be permitted to sell Mineral water at extra premium to the Corporation.

The following instructions are therefore issued for strict compliance:

① Wherever licences have been issued to any contractor for sale of Mineral water on exclusive basis only such licensees shall be permitted to sell Mineral Water in such Bus Stations and permission to sell Mineral Water shall not be given to any other licensee.

2) In all other places where no such exclusive licences have been given the Regional Tender Committee should meet and notify to the licensees of Stalls/Canteens in all the Bus Stations under its jurisdiction that all the licensees shall be permitted to sell Mineral Water only after paying additional licence fee.

The additional licence fee shall be fixed by the Regional Tender Committee based on the importance of the Bus Station.

4) Based on the recommendations of the Tender Committee and approval of the Executive Director concerned, the Regional Manager shall issue licences to the licensees of Stalls/Canteens who agree to pay the additional licence fee for the sale of Mineral water. Those who do not agree to pay the additional amount towards the sale of the Mineral Water shall not be permitted to sell Mineral water.

5) The date of expiry of licence of any Stall/  
Licensee will not change. In other words, the permission for  
sale of Mineral Water shall be co-terminus with the existing  
period of agreement.

6) This condition shall be incorporated in the  
existing Agreement already entered into with the licensees  
of Stalls/Canteens.

7) This process should be completed by 30th April,  
2001.


