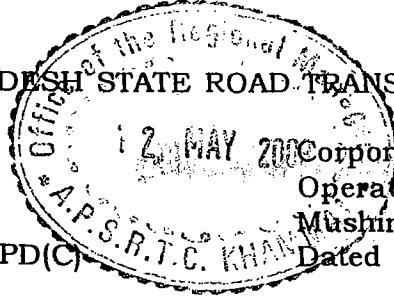

Sub: **LICENSING** - Sale of mineral water in Bus Stations by the existing licensees on payment of additional licence fee - Modification of earlier instructions - Reg.

Ref: 1. Circular No.19/2001-OPD(C), dated. 12-04-2001.
2. Circular No.12/2003-OPD(C), dated. 13-02-2003.

Instructions were issued vide circulars cited on allowing the existing licensees of Stalls/Shops at Bus Stations to sell mineral water on payment of additional licence fee as decided/fixed by the Tender Committee, which should not be less than the amount communicated vide circular 2nd cited, depending upon the classification of Bus Station.

In partial modification of the instructions communicated vide circulars cited, the following instructions are issued.

1. In Bus Stations, where licence is given for sale of mineral water exclusively, no other licensee shall be permitted to sell mineral water.

The licensee of exclusive mineral water stall or existing licensees of other stalls who are permitted to sell mineral water on payment of additional licence fee, shall be allowed to sell only reputed company made mineral water with BIS or ISI Standards like Bisleri, Kinley, Aqua Fina in packed bottles of 1 litre and 2 litres and they should not be allowed to sell mineral water manufactured by local companies/ or safe drinking water in bottles or sachets of 100 ml. or 200 ml.

2. If permission is given to any existing licensee of a Stall/Shop to sell mineral water on payment of additional licence fee prior to allotment of exclusive mineral water stall, it shall be continued till the expiry of the licence period of the stall.

3. In Bus Stations, where exclusive "Water KIOSK" is installed to sell safe drinking water, licensees of other Stalls/Shops can be permitted to sell mineral water of reputed companies in packed bottles, on payment of additional licence fee as fixed by the Tender Committee by following the guidelines/instructions communicated vide circular 2nd cited.

4. In Bus Stations, where there is exclusive KIOSK to sell safe drinking water (water KIOSK), such licensee shall be allowed to sell safe drinking water in 1 litre or 2 litre bottles and also sachets of 100 ml. or 200 ml. as per the following rates and the licensee shall not be allowed to sell mineral water.



- a) For filling of safe drinking water in One litre bottle. : Rs. 3.00
(Rupees Three Only)
- b) For supply of safe drinking water along with One litre bottle. : Rs. 5.00
(Rupees Five Only)
- c) For sale of safe drinking water in
- i) 200 ml sealed Sachet : Rs. 2.00 (Rupees Two Only)
- ii) 100 ml sealed Sachet : Re. 1.00 (Rupee One Only)

The above instructions shall be followed scrupulously without any deviations. The instructions communicated vide circulars cited are modified to the extent as indicated above and other instructions shall remain un-changed.
