Sub: ELECTRICITY CHARGES: Collection of Electricity Charges from the licensees of Canteens, Stalls/Shops, Office accommodation, Advertising Agents, ANL Parcel Service, Person Weighing Machines etc.- Communication of Revised Tariffs - Regarding.

The APTRANSCO has revised the Electricity tariffs with effect from 4.8.2000.

Accordingly, Circular 25/2000-MED, dated: 30.6.2000 was issued, Communicating the Electricity Charges applicable to different types of Consumers.

In view of the revision of tariff by APTRANSCO, revised electricity charges are to be collected from (a) Licensees of Canteens, Stalls/ Shops, Office accommodation (b) Advertising Agents (c) ANL Parcel Service for the accommodation provided to it in our Bus Stations and Premises and (d) Person Weighing Machines installed in our bus stations.

The Electricity Charges applicable in respect of the Bus Stations falling under L.T. Category-II i.e., NON-DOMESTIC AND COMMERCIAL - such as Stalls, Offices etc. are furnished hereunder:

LICENSEES OF CANTEENS, STALLS / SHOPS. Office  
ACCOMMODATION ETC., ADVERTISING AGENTS, AND PARCEL  
SERVICE, PERSON WEIGHING MACHINES AND CCTV

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| 1) Where Power is supplied through a separate meter with AP TRANSCO service connection. | Total amount as per the bill received from AP TRANSCO.   |
| 2) Where Power is supplied through a sub-meter.   | i) Rs. 7.45 per unit + 06 paise per unit. Engineer (Electrical). Only charges @ Rs. 7.51/per Unit have to be collected in time under L.T. Category-II. |

Installation of sub-meters duly tested by APTRANSCO MHT, shall be insisted wherever sub-meters are not yet provided, for correct assessment and realisation of Electricity Charges.

All sub-meters of Stalls/Shops etc. shall have to be fitted at Bus Station Manager's Room under Lock and Key Custody and at all times they must be in working condition.

The working of Weighing Machines shall be - from 6.00 hrs. to 22.00 hrs. In any case, if the Person Weighing Machines are put to use for more than the stipulated time, proportionate Electricity Charges shall be collected from the Company/Firm. The Electricity Charges should be commensurate with the Electricity consumed by the Company/Firm of Person Weighing Machines installed in Bus Stations. A separate 1 Phase Sub-Meter to be fixed for recording the consumption.

The following Bus Stations come under H.T. Category (II) - Mahatma Gandhi Bus Station, Hyderabad (1) Pandit Nehru Bus Station, Vijayawada (3) Dwaraka Bus Station, Visakhapatnam and Bus Stations at Guntur, Warangal, Tirupathi, Nellore.

In respect of the Bus Stations which are falling under H.T. category (II), electricity charges have to be collected as per the rates applicable to H.T. Category (II) including M.D. charges etc. based on each month's consumption, as detailed in the circular 2nd cited, in consultation with Dy. Executive Engineer (Electrical) concerned.

The revised rates are applicable with effect from 04-06-2000.

All the Unit Officers are advised to collect the electricity charges at the revised rates regularly in time, without giving scope for wrong calculation and accumulation of arrears towards Electricity Charges.

The licensees / Advertising Agents / ANL Parcel Service etc. shall not be allowed to use Electrical Heaters, Electrical Stoves and other heavy electrical appliances in the premises of Corporation. Care should be taken and keep a close watch about un-authorized tapping of Electricity from our Stalls at Bus Stations.

The Regional Managers shall ensure that Electrical Charges are being assessed and realised in full from the licensees of Stalls/Shops/Canteens etc. Advertising Agents, Company / Firm of Weighing Machines basing on the actual consumption of Electricity.
