Sub: SPECIAL HIRE - General Elections to House of People and A.P. Legislative Assembly '99 - Provision of buses for transportation of men and material on hire basis - Instructions issued - Reg.

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The Chief Electoral Officer & Spl. Chief Secretary to Government of Andhra Pradesh through the letter 4th cited has informed that the General Elections to House of People and A.P. Legislative Assembly, 1999 are scheduled to be held in three (3) phases in Andhra Pradesh i.e., on 05.09.1999, 11.09.1999 and 18.09.1999. It is therefore requested to arrange to provide buses to the Collectors and District Election Officer/Superintendents of Police/Commissioner, DCH for transportation of Polling & Police personnel and Polling material for the said Elections as and when requisitioned.

The following instructions are therefore issued for strict compliance by the Regional Managers / Depot Managers.

1) Buses shall be supplied to the possible extent on receipt of requisitions from the District Collector/Returning Officer/Superintendent of Police concerned, as it is likely that a large number of buses may be requisitioned for the purpose.

2) Hire charges shall be claimed @ Rs.4,300/- per bus per day in terms of G.O.Ms.No.106, Dt.27.03.98 and hire charges are to be realised immediately after the Elections are over.

3) DGTs shall be provided on receipt of requisitions from the authorities concerned for transporting ballot papers from Govt. Printing Presses to various places in the State. Hire charges shall be claimed @ Rs.18/- per KM. as fixed by the Govt. communicated vide this Office Circular cited at 1 above.

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- 4) Provision of buses shall be planned by pooling them from nearby Depots as far as possible and to ensure that maximum number of regular scheduled services be operated.
- 5) Whenever the period of detention exceeds 12 hours in a calendar day, it is treated as one full day and where the period of detention is less than 12 hours, in a calendar day, it is treated as half day.
- 6) The period of detention shall be counted from the time it reports before the requisitioning Officer and till the time of release of the vehicle by the requisitioning Officer.
- 7) The Regional Managers/Dy.Chief Traffic Managers in Zones and Regions shall associate themselves fully in planning and scheduling the activities relating to buses and coordinate with the District Election Officers and the Collectors in regard to provision of special buses for Election purpose.
- 8) Scope shall not be given for complaints.

A report on the operational details such as number of buses supplied in the Region, hire charges worked out, bill claimed etc., be sent to this Office by 23.09.1999 positively.
