Sub: Monthly Season Tickets – Rationalisation of MST Tariffs with more Passenger friendly features – Instructions issued – Reg.

1. Introduction :

On reviewing the sale of monthly seasons tickets upto Mar'11 compared with sales upto Mar'10, there is a huge drop in sale of Pallevelugu MSTs as shown hereunder.

2. Nomenclature of new Monthly Season Tickets :

The nomenclature of Monthly Season Tickets is changed as :

- --- 20 30 PVG Silver Card with a tag line of "Pay for 20 days and travel for 30 days"
- --- 20 30 EXP Silver Card with a tag line of "Pay for 20 days and travel for 30 days"
- --- 60 90 PVG Gold Card with a tag line of "Pay for 60 days and travel for 90 days"
- --- 60 90 EXP Gold Card with a tag line of "Pay for 60 days and travel for 90 days"

3. Salient features of Silver & Gold Cards :

- Silver & Gold cards are issued for Monthly & Quarterly periods, separately for Pallevelugu and Express types.
- Silver & Gold cards are issued upto 75 Kms with 5 Kms slabs.
- Passengers intending to travel from 76th km to 100th Km are facilitated to travel with a single slab tariff of 80 Kms fare.
- There are no child tickets in Silver & Gold cards category.
- > For first two stages Silver & Gold cards is not issued for Express buses.

4. Revised Tariffs of Monthly (Silver) & Quarterly (Gold) Cards :

To improve the patronage of the Silver & Gold Cards and making them passenger friendly, the tariffs have been rationalized. Passengers can purchase Silver cards for one month and Gold cards for three months as per their convenience.

The revised tariff of Silver & Gold cards are as follows.

5. Value Additions to attract more clientele :

- Luggage of Silver & Gold card holder should be allowed free of cost in buses.
- Gold card holders (Quarterly card) shall be provided insurance on the lines of Vanita Family Card, i.e., One Lakh Rupees compensation in case of loss of life while traveling in our buses.
- Pallevelugu Silver & Gold card holder is allowed to travel in EXP buses, by collecting a flat fare of Rs.5/- for any distance, on the lines of combi ticket for Students.
 - Express Silver & Gold card holder is allowed to travel in Deluxe buses by paying Rs.10/- flat fare for any distance.
 - Express Silver & Gold card holders are allowed to travel in NON-STOP express buses also.

6. GIFT Scheme for Silver & Gold card holders :

• TWO Gifts for each Region may be given to Silver & Gold card holders holders, one for PVG Silver/Gold card holders and one for EXP Silver/Gold card holders. Gifts worth of Rs.2000/- for PVG Silver & Gold card holders and Rs.3000/- for EXP Silver & Gold card holders are to be given every month. Depots should send the previous month dump of PVG & EXP Silver & Gold cards to RMs Office by 5th of every month. Draw shall be taken by 10th of every month and winners should be awarded through media and also exhibited in the Bus stations for convenience of the Silver & Gold card holders. The winning Silver & Gold card holders numbers may be selected by random generation of sold Silver & Gold card numbers using the computer program which will be developed by IT department. The gift scheme is valid upto Dec, 2011.

7. Publicity measures to be undertaken for Silver & Gold Cards :

Banners to be prepared with the following captions in Telugu and to be displayed at all bus stations and also at Silver & Gold Cards issuing counters.

- 20 30 Pallevelugu SILVER CARD : 10 Rojula Uchita Prayanam
- 60 90 Pallevelugu GOLD CARD : 30 Rojula Uchita Prayanam
- 20 30 Express SILVER CARD
- : 10 Rojula Uchita Prayanam
- 60 90 Express GOLD CARD : 30Rojula Uchita Prayanam

Value additions mentioned at item-5, shall also be incorporated in the banners.

- Pamphlets to be prepared and distributed to the traveling public particularly to the office goers petty vendors and business people.
- Crew should be educated thoroughly over the additional value added facilities provided to the Silver and Gold card holders, especially on the 'combi' ticket facility.

8. Printing, Stocking & Distribution of revised model Silver & Gold cards.

Works Manager, printing press, Miyapur shall arrange to print the monthly & quarterly passes with the approved design. Sufficient stock shall be printed and supplied to Zonal stores for onward distribution to Depots.

With the introduction of the new model Silver & Gold Cards, the existing stock on hand of old model shall have to be treated as obsolete and shall be burnt after audit as per the existing procedure. Old stock shall not be issued under any circumstances from 1st Jul, 2011 onwards.

9. Launching of the Scheme.

All the Regional Managers are advised to launch Silver & Gold Cards on 01.07.2011 by inviting local VIPs duly conducting a meeting. Media personnel shall also be invited to the launching programme for press coverage.

Compliance report shall be submitted with the details of press clippings / Photos of launching programme to this office.
