Sub: BREAD WINNER SCHEME – Considering the spouse or children of deceased employees for compassionate appointment as Security Guards under Bread Winner Scheme – Instructions issued - Reg

Ref: 1. Circular No.PD-99/1986 dated 19.08.1986
2. Circular No.PD-2/1998 dated 19.03.1998

The spouse or children of the deceased employees were being considered for compassionate appointment to the post of Security Guards under Bread Winner Scheme subject to eligibility in terms of Circular under reference 1st cited. Subsequently, such compassionate appointments were limited to the productive categories of Driver Gr II, Conductor Gr II and Shramik vide instructions issued through Circular under reference 2nd cited. Later compassionate appointments under BWS were not considered following the instruction of the Government vide GO Ms.No.36 dated 05.09.2001.

On restoration of the BWS through Notifications No. PD-04/2013 dated 02.03.2013 and PD-03/2014 dated 01.03.2014, despite considering the registered applications for the posts of Driver Gr II, Conductor Gr II and Shramiks, it is observed that there are still a large number of applications pending for want of sanctioned vacancies in the above categories.

In order to mitigate the hardship to the bereaved families, there is need to provided compassionate appointments to the spouse or children of the deceased with least possible delay. Since the scope of vacancies arising in the categories of Driver Gr II, Conductor Gr II and Shramiks, is limited to consider the large number of pending applications under BWS, it is decided to consider the pending applications registered under BWS for filling the sanctioned vacancies in the cadre of RTC Constables also subject to eligibility as per APSRTC Employees' (Recruitment) Regulations, 1966 pending ratification by the Board and approval from the Government. It is expected that the pendency of applications registered under BWS will be cleared to a large extent by bringing the post of RTC Constable under the purview of BWS.

Hence, all the Recruiting Authorities are hereby advised to provide an opportunity to the already registered applicants by calling for their willingness for the post of RTC Constable and go ahead with selection of willing candidates to the post of RTC Constable subject to such willing candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria as per recruitment regulations and other instructions issued on the subject from time to time and subject to availability of sanctioned vacancies. It is also advised that hence forth, applications shall also be registered for the post of RTC Constable also from eligible applicants under BWS in future.

These instructions will come into force with immediate effect and have the approval of the competent authority.
