Sub: RECRUITMENT REGULATIONS - Amendment to APSRTC Employees' (Recruitment) Regulations, 1966 to the posts of Senior Medical Officer (Specialist), Medical Officer (Specialist) and Medical Officer (General) - Reg.

Ref:- APSRTC Board resolution no.35/2013, dt. 30.04.2013.

A proposal was placed before the Board to stipulate a condition in the qualification in respect of Senior Medical Officer and Medical Officers that the PG Degree/PG Diploma possessed by the candidates in related clinical speciality should be recognized and approved by the Medical Council of India (MCI)

The proposal was accepted by the Board and the Board through the Resolution cited, has accorded approval for amending the Method of recruitment and qualifications for the posts of Medical Officer(General), Medical Officer (Specialist) and Senior Medical Officer (Specialist).


The proposals have been forwarded to the Government to communicate its approval to the proposed Amendment. The Chairman has accorded approval for implementing the amended Recruitment Regulations to the said posts pending approval of the Government.

The existing and amended Regulations are at Annexure A, B & C for Senior Medical Officer(Specialist), Medical Officer(Specialist) and Medical Officer(General) respectively.

The Amended Regulations will come into force with immediate effect. All recruiting authorities are advised to take note of the same and act accordingly.
