Sub: DELEGATION OF POWERS – Restructuring of erstwhile Regions in APSRTC into DPTOs on lines of GoAP – Guidelines on Delegation of Powers in the revised administrative set up – Instructions – Reg.

Vide reference 2nd cited, the erstwhile Regional and Zonal setup in APSRTC was restructured into Districts and Zones with revised jurisdictions consequent to the restructuring of erstwhile 13 revenue districts into 26 new districts in the state of AP.

2. Consequently, the erstwhile 12 Regions in APSRTC under the administrative control of one Regional Manager for each region, are reconstituted into 26 District Public Transport Offices (DPTOs) coterminous with restructured districts under the administrative control of one District Public Transport Officer (DPTO) for each District and officers in the ranks of Regional Manager, Senior Scale and Junior Scale were posted as DPTOs. The erstwhile zones have been restructured into Zones-I, II, III and IV coterminous with the zonal system of GoAP.

3. In the revised set up, the changes in the administrative structure in comparison to the erstwhile Regional/Zonal set up are given below

4. Revision of Sanctioning / Approving authority:

In the revised DPTO and Zonal set up, need arises to revise the Delegation of Powers-2014, in respect of the subjects pertaining to various departments like OPD, MED, AD, PD, IT, CED, PR, Medical etc., to enable the authorities at District level to accord sanctions and take decision on the day to day subject matters. After detailed study and discussions with EDs, DPTOs etc., the following modifications in the Delegation of Powers - 2014 are approved.

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4.1 The powers delegated to Regional Manager/Senior Scale Officer rank officers working in erstwhile Regional set up, are now delegated to District Public Transport Officers (DPTO) heading the Districts Irrespective of the cadre i.e., RM or SSO. In respect of ASR District, the Dy.CTM(O&C):Zone-I will exercise the powers of DPTO in this aspect.

4.2 In case of the MED subjects such as repairs to buses/bodies, repairs to plants and machinery etc., the proposals initiated by the Depots/Units shall be scrutinized by the Dy.CME:Zone concerned before processing for sanction of respective DPTO/ED as applicable.

4.3 In case of the OPD subjects such as Jatharas, special operations/events etc., the proposal initiated by the Depots/Units shall be scrutinized by the Dy.CTM(O&C):Zone or Dy.CTM: District concerned as applicable before processing for sanction of respective DPTO/ED.

4.4 The authorities vested with the powers to give financial concurrence on the files involving expenditures are modified as given below.

5. DOP in respect of Depots/Units, Zonal NoUs and Head Office:

Since there is no change in the organisational hierarchy and authorities heading the Depots/Units at Depots, NoUs and HO, there is no need to modify the Delegation of Powers already assigned to the respective authorities. Hence, the Delegation of Powers in respect of such authorities concerned remain unaltered.

6. These changes given above in the operation of Delegation of Powers at DPTOs will come into force with immediate effect. All the pending cases pertaining to sanctions involving financial expenditures shall also be disposed off in accordance with the revised delegation of powers.
