SUB:-REMFS – 2003 – Non-applicability of REMFS-2003 to the employees of PTD who Retire from service on Superannuation or Voluntary grounds on or after 01.01.2020 - Notification issued – Regarding.

The APSRTC Retired Employees Medical Facilities Scheme (REMFS) -2003 was introduced with effect from 01.01.2006 for providing medical treatment to the employees of APSRTC who retire from service on Superannuation, as per the terms of the Scheme. Subsequently in the year 2019, the scheme was extended to the employees who retire from service on voluntary grounds also.


All Employees of APSRTC were absorbed into Government service with effect from 01.01.2020 duly creating a new Head of the Department by name "Public Transport Department" under the administrative control of T, R&B Department.

As per item no. 18 of the report of Secretaries' Committee **which was approved by the Government,**

1. Medical facilities provided presently under REMFS-2003 to the employees already retired in APSRTC prior to 01.01.2020 shall be continued as these retired employees had paid the applicable subscription amount based on the cadres, at the time of superannuation or VRS.
2. After absorption, REMFS-2003 shall not be applicable to the employees of PTD i.e., from 01.01.2020 onwards.

In view of the above, it is hereby notified that Retired Employees Medical Facilities Scheme (REMFS-2003) is not applicable to the employees of PTD who retire from service on superannuation/voluntary grounds on or after 01.01.2020.

Necessary action shall be taken accordingly by all Unit Officers.
