Sub:- RECRUITMENT - Recruitment of candidates who were removed from service and applied for re-employment - Instructions - Issued.

It is reported that Conductors who have been removed from service in terms of APSRTC Employees' (CC&A) Regulations, for involving in Cash & Ticket Irregularity cases are getting selected again in APSRTC by concealing the fact of their past employment. In most of the cases, these Conductors have been removed from service having cheated and duped the Organisation of its valuable revenue.

A candidate who indulged in such activities and removed from service after due process of enquiry is not desirable to be appointed in APSRTC again.

Some units have sought clarification on re-employment of Conductors who have been removed from service.

The matter has been examined in detail and it is decided that no employee who has been removed from service should be considered for appointment again in the services of the Corporation.

If a candidate has been considered for appointment without the knowledge of his previous employment and removal from the services of APSRTC, action be initiated by the competent authority to terminate his services duly following the procedure in vogue on disciplinary matters and the main charge would be "obtaining Employment duly concealing his previous employment".

All the recruiting authorities, are therefore, advised to adhere to the instructions issued in this regard while conducting recruitment particularly for the posts of Driver and Conductor.
