Sub: RECRUITMENT - Reservation of 33 1/3% of posts in favour of Women in all direct recruitment posts - Principle of carry forward in implementing reservation of posts for Women on par with SCs/STs, BCs - Implementing Government Orders - Instructions - Issued.

The Government of Andhra Pradesh vide G.O.Ms.No.56, dated 28.10.1996 have introduced the principle of carry forward in implementing the 33 1/3% reservation of posts for Women on par with Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.

In order to implement the orders of Government, the Corporation Board vide Resolution No.82/1998, dated 30.6.1998 have approved for implementation of the carry forward provisions of vacancies reserved for Women on par with Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.

The existing procedure for implementing 33 1/3% reservation of posts in favour of Women as communicated vide Circular 5th cited is that when no suitable eligible Women candidates are available for any particular group the vacancies shall be filled by Men of the same Group.

As per the amended Regulations the vacancies earmarked for all groups of Women have to be carried forward, to three successive recruitment years on par with SC/ST/BC candidates.

The amended Regulation 12(2)(i) of APSRTC Employees Recruitment Regulations 1965 is shown in the Annexure for implementation.

This amendment is deemed to have come into force w.e.f. 30.06.1998 i.e., the date of Board's Resolution.

**AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION 12(2)(i) OF A.P.S.R.T.C.
EMPLOYEES' (RECRUITMENT) REGULATIONS 1966.**

EXISTING **AMENDED**
 (Notified vide Circular No.
 PD-91/96, dated 16.10.1996)

In the matter of ~~of~~ all direct recruitment posts for which Women and Men are equally suited there shall be reservation to Women to an extent of $33\frac{1}{3}\%$ of the posts in each category of OC, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, ST, SC, PHC, Ex-serviceman quota.

Provided that if sufficient No. of Women candidates are not available, the vacancies shall be filled by Men.

No Change

The vacancies earmarked for all Groups of Women have to be carried forward to three successive recruitment year on par with SC/ST/BC candidates.
