Sub:- RECRUITMENT - Recruitment to the post of Drivers on Contract basis - Clarification regarding break in Heavy Vehicle Driving Licence - Issued - Reg.

As per the Recruitment Regulations, candidates should be in possession of HGV/HPV licence for a period of five years on the date of selection.

Some of the recruiting authorities are seeking clarification in regard to the Break in the period of Heavy Vehicle Driving Licence for computing the 5 years continuity.

The matter has been examined and the clarification issued through the Circular 1st cited regarding the computation of the driving licence experience continuous to be in force. It is clarified thereon that if a candidate maintain the prescribed period of 3 years out of the total period of Heavy Vehicle Driving Licence held by him excluding the period lost due to late renewals licence suspensions etc., if any, their cases are to be considered.

The same analogy can be applied for computing 5 years Driving Licence experience for selection of Driver post at present.
