Sub: MEDICAL EXAMINATION - Periodical Medical Examination of Drivers-
Instructions- Re-iterated.

Instructions were issued through the circular 1st cited that Drivers shall be examined medically at the termination of every period of 3 years calculated from the date of appointment until they attain the age of 45 years, and thereafter annually until conclusion of their service. Further instructions were issued vide the circular 2nd cited synchronizing the periodical medical examination of Drivers, who are below the age of 45 years, with the renewal of their Driving Licence. These instructions were re-iterated through the circulars 3rd to 8th cited for strict implementation, duly stipulating that all the Drivers in A1 category, whether they are in the cadre of light vehicle or heavy vehicle should undergo periodical medical examination without fail.

The Hon'ble High Court of AP in WP No.20228/05 directed the APSRTC on 27.12.2005 to undertake the task of having a Medical/ Vision check-up done for all its Drivers. Therefore, all the Regional Managers through the ref.,9th cited were advised to arrange to conduct Medical Examination of all the Drivers in their respective Region. Accordingly, a special drive was conducted to get all the Drivers medically examined.

However, in order to avoid accidents due to poor medical fitness of Drivers, all the Depot Managers/ Controlling Authorities are once again advised to ensure that all the Drivers who are below the age of 45 years are directed once in 3 years for periodical medical examination (whenever the renewal of their driving licence falls due irrespective of their date of appointment) and thereafter annually, until cessation of employment in APSRTC.
