The remuneration payable to the Medical Officers engaged on contract basis was last communicated vide reference 2^{nd} cited. The same has been reviewed.

The Vice Chairman & Managing Director with the concurrence of FA & CAO has accorded approval for enhancement of the consolidated monthly remuneration payable to the Medical Officers (Specialist) with PG degree engaged on contract basis as shown below:-

MO (Specialist) with PG Degree except specialization in Gen.Medicine, Gen.Surgery and Radiology.	Rs.30,000/-	Rs. 40,000
MO (Specialist) specialized in Gen.Medicine, Gen.Surgery and Radiology.	Rs.30,000/-	Rs.45,000/-

This enhanced remuneration is applicable only for the specialist doctors who are discharging their duties in the core discipline.

There is no change in the remuneration payable in respect of Medical Officer (General) and the existing remuneration will continue.

The duty hours in respect of the Medical Officers (both General &Specialist) engaged on contract basis will be from 08.30 AM to 2.30 PM.

These instructions will come in to force with immediate effect.
