Sub:- RECRUITMENT - Welfare of the Handicapped - Amendments to Regulation 12(2)(b) of A.P.S.R.T.C. Employees' Recruitment Regulations, 1366 - Special drive to fill up the vacancies reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates - Instructions - Issued.

The Government have issued instructions that the vacancias carmarked for Physically Handicapped candidates should be filled up on War footing basis treating it as a special drive. While issuing instructions the Government fixed a dead-line that the vacancies should be filled up by the first week of February, 1993. Since the Corporation has already crossed the dead-line, the first week in the following instructions are issued for expeditious action.

1. For all direct recruitment posts, physically Handicapped candidates are not suitable in view of the nature of duties attached to the post. Therefore, an Expert Committee comprising Superintendent & Chief Medical Officer, Chief Engineer 'Mechanical'(Operations), Chief Manager(P) and Chief Manager (HRD) has identified only 62 direct recruitment posts for which the Physically Handicapped candidates can be considered. The 62 posts identified by the Expert Committee are shown at Annexure—'A' enclosed to the Circular.

The roster point Nos. 6, 31 and 56 are earmarked for 'Blind', 'Deaf' and Orthopaedically Handicapped' respectively. In case of non-availability of Physically Handicapped candidate of a particular category, to a particular post, it can be filled up by another category of Physically handicapped, provided he is found suitable for the post. The vacancy meant for physically handicapped candidates should be carried forward on a cumulative basis till it lapses to the general pool at the end of the third succeeding year.

- 3. For taking a decision whether a particular candidate is Physically Handicapped or not, the definitions and explanations contained in Corporation Resolution No. 107/89 nations contained in Corporation Resolution No. 107/89 dated 14.8.1989 shall be taken as guidelines. The said Resolution is shown at Annexure 'B' enclosed to this Circular.
- 4. The candidates selected under Physically handicapped quota in Regions and Divisions shall be directed to Superintendent and Chief Medical Officer; APSRTC, Hospital, Tarnaka for medical examination.

The recruiting authorities should assess the vacancies existing in each cadre, place requisitions on the Employment Exchanges concerned and take up the recruitment on top priority basis treating it as a special drive.

The number of vacancies in each cadre existing for Physically handicapped be informed to this Office besides taking action to fill up the same.
