

CIRCULAR NO.PD-45/2008, DT.06.10.2008.

Sub:- RECRUITMENT - Reservation in appointment for Socially and Educationally Backward classes of Muslims as category 'E' in the list of BCs in addition to the existing ABCD categories - Implementation - Reg.

In terms of Regulation 12 of APSRTC Employees (Recruitment) Regulations, 1966, the Recruitment to all the Direct recruitment posts has to be done in accordance with the reservations and Roster specified for BCs.

The Government through its G.Os cited under reference 2 & 3, Backward Classes Welfare Department has issued orders providing 4% reservation to socially and educationally Backward Classes of Muslims in Public employment in the state (other than Dudekula, Ladaff, Pinjari, Noor basha and Mehtar). It was also ordered there in to include them in the list of BCs, in addition to the existing 'A', 'B', 'C' & 'D' categories under a separate category 'E'.

By virtue of providing reservations to the Socially and Educationally Backward classes of Muslims in the matter of appointments in Public services in the state, the total reservations to BCs comes to 29%.

The Government, after examining the entire issue in detail revised the roster points for reservation among the (5) five categories of BCs in a Unit of 100 vacancies as detailed in the annexure to the G.O 3rd cited.

In order to fall in line with the policy of the Government of A.P., it is decided to implement 4% reservation to socially and educationally Backward Classes of Muslims as notified in the G.O.Ms.No.23, dt. 07.07.2007, under a separate category "E", in addition to the existing "A", "B", "C" & "D" Categories, in all Direct Recruitments of APSRTC, pending ratification by Board and sanction by State Government.

In view of the above G.Os of the Government, the 100 points Roster indicating all reservations including the Four (4) BC-E points for Muslims is enclosed at Annexure-A along with the list of castes as notified by the Government under the category of BC-E at Annexure-B for ready reference and for implementation in all Direct Recruitments of APSRTC duly incorporating the following clause scrupulously in the notifications to be issued.

"The candidate belonging and claiming to be Backward Classes Group-E, may apply indicating their community as BC-E. However, providing reservation to BC-E group will be subject to the adjudications of the litigation pending before the Honorable Courts and subject to orders of the Government, from time to time."

The implementation of reservation for the newly incorporated Backward Classes of Muslims under "E" category will come into force with immediate effect in the revised Roster.


