Sub: **RECRUITMENT** - Direct Recruitment in Class-I, Class-II, Class-III and Class-IV posts in Medical Department - Selection Procedure - Reg.
Ref: Circular No.PD-34/2000 dt.26.05.2000.

Through Circular cited, Guidelines for selection in Class-I, Class-II and Class-III posts to all direct recruitment posts except Medical Department were issued.

The criteria for selection of Medical Officers is by interview only. There is no specific guidelines existing for apportionment of marks for selection of Medical Officers and Para Medical Staff. Further, some of the Universities are not issuing Memorandum of marks for MBBS Degree and PG Degree/PG Diploma, but they are awarding only pass certificates.

The VC & MD approved the proposals suggested by the Superintendent & Chief Medical Officer for selection of Medical Officers and Para Medical Staff in the Corporation as follows:
